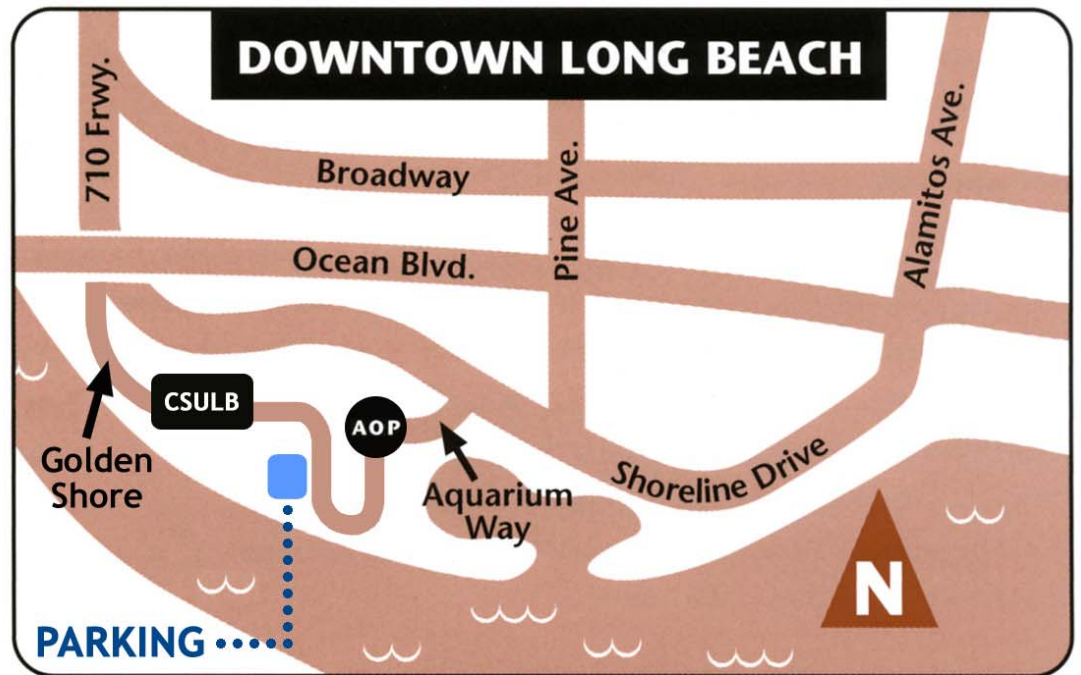

Follow signs for Downtown Long Beach. Go past 6th Street and Broadway exits. Exit Golden Shore/Catalina Landing. Turn right on Golden Shore.

From Long Beach or south of Long Beach:

Take Ocean Boulevard west.
Turn left on Golden Shore.

Parking

Once on Golden Shore, proceed *past* the CSULB Chancellor's office and Catalina Landing. Turn right at the fork. Drive a short distance and park in the **open-air lot** that is reserved for Workshop attendees. (Please note, this is **not** the CSULB lot or Catalina Landing parking structure).
